"Democratic ties and citizens"

How have globalisation and the European integration process influenced the relationship to the politics of European citizens?

How have changes in public policies, characterised in particular by strong budgetary constraints, affected democratic ties?

The Qualidem project, funded by the European Research Council, examines the erosion of the democratic ties of a growing number of European citizens.

"Interior enemies"

It is difficult to determine whether democracy is the best or the least bad form of government, what is certain is that it is the most fragile one. Its external enemies, real as they are, are sometimes the scarecrow hiding a deeper evil that erodes it from within... Rwanda, Senegal, Jordan. From Africa to the Middle East, in the field of land and water policies, or of education and gender, what kind of local resistance to international injunctions can emerge? Can an alternative societal project to Western modernity emerge? This research examines the alternative societal project to Western modernity that can result from it.
