SUSEET SUMMER SCHOOL IN EUROPEAN ENVIRONMENTAL TAXATION

SUSEET is a Summer School in European Environmental Taxation that will take place at the University of Naples from 22nd to 28th June 2020 with the support of European Union (Jean Monnet Module 611159-EPP-1-2019-1-IT-EPPJMO-MODULE). It is a seven-day residential course where 20 undergraduate students who are achieving their degree in law or economics or postgraduate students (master or Ph.D.) will learn the fundamentals of European environmental taxation, becoming aware of the complex economic and social issues related to this topic. SUSEET has been designed to provide participants with suitable expertise on environmental taxation, useful both for the construction of an academic career and for a professional one, contributing to the creation of a new generation of European environmental tax lawyers. It will provide the occasion for participants coming from all over the world to discuss with eminent professors or experts working in this field.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE:

To provide a comprehensive view on economic and legal basis of environmental taxation;

To explore the European constraints to the introduction of fiscal instruments to protect the environment: State Aid rules, freedom of movement, prohibition of discrimination etc.;

To illustrate the multiple interactions between tax and environment in terms of global policies and their economic and social effects;

To demonstrate the challenges and new opportunities provided by the circular economy;

To analyse energy taxation principles and their concrete application in the framework of the EU energy transition strategy;

To discuss fiscal mechanisms to support green tax reforms.

STRUCTURE OF THE COURSE AND CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE

The summer school will consist of 52 hours of teaching activities structured around 10 lectures and 3 laboratories. The theoretical and practical approach will be mixed: every lecture will be followed by the examination of European case-law or case-studies in which space will be given to the discussion with participants. The course will end with a final workshop at Villa Orlandi, one of the best conference hall of the Federico II University, located on the island of Capri.

Participants who actively participate in the whole course will be issued with a certificate of attendance.

WHO CAN APPLY

Undergraduate students that are achieving their degree in law or economics and master or Ph.D. students interested in developing their expertise in European environmental taxation.
